Private entities can contact Croatian Red Cross at donacije@hck.hr to agree on the food and supplies they would like to donate. Red Cross published type of goods that are needed:

- a) **durable food** – flour, oil, rice, pasta, water, cans etc.
- b) **hygiene** – soap, shampoo, toilet paper etc.
- c) **protection equipment** – medical mask, protection suit, gloves, alcohol hand sanitizers etc.

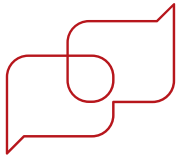

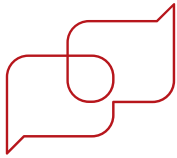

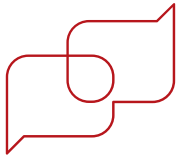

11. UNICEF

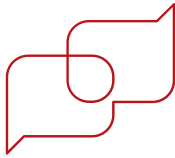

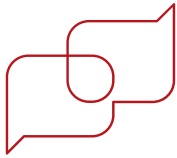
